We do this through our STEM, Employability and Construction programmes. Within each of these we have key activities which we deliver to different year groups and cohorts of students. All our activities are supported by volunteers from the world of work, deliver Gatsby benchmark 5 and develop key transferable skills. Specific events may also deliver on benchmarks 2, 3 and 4.

### FOCUS ON SKILLS

#### SKILLS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

Essential skills, transferrable skills or soft skills, whatever they are called, are vital for a successful transition from education into the world of work.

Building skills-learning into your careers programme is key to supporting young people's future success. Indeed students not only need to learn the skills, but also be able to articulate them and give examples of times when they have used those skills.

As a delivery partner of SkillsBuilder, we embed the Framework into our activities to give them a strong foundation in the key skills, and work with employers to help us deliver this through Gatsby Benchmark 5. You can also work with your staff to deliver skills through BM4 'Careers in the curriculum' by asking them to identify skills they might be using and (bonus points!) linking those skills to a particular career.
